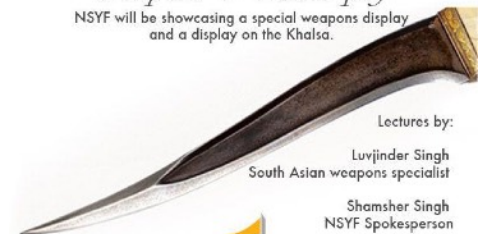

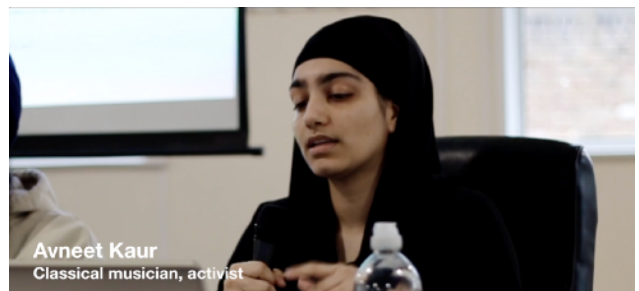

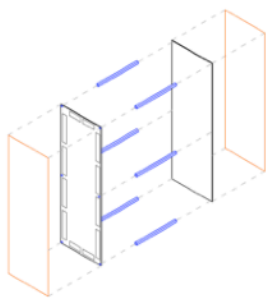

Our second exhibition was build around a Sikh coin collection that was donated to Sri Guru Singh Sabha Gurdwara Southall. We worked with experts in the field to present a clear sovereignty based narrative that told the story of Sikh coins in the context of Sikh Raj.

Sikhs, bestowed sovereignty on us in the Khanda, we earned it with tributes alone.

Wherever we settle on the earth we establish sovereignty for the Khanda of Māra.

Sikh coins were struck under the Republic of Banda Singh Bahadur (1710), the Confederacy of the Sikh Khals (1710-1716) and during the reign of Maharaja Ranjit Singh (1799-1839). Building upon the political achievements of the Gurus, the Sikhs established further towns and cities, levied taxes, constructed forts, and raised armies to further the Sikh Khanda. Coins were minted as a show of established economic strength in one of the most truly disputed territories across the sub-continent.

The Sikh Khanda was strategically placed across the land of the Sea, stretching from Peshawar in the West, to Amritsar in the East, and Kashmir in the North to Multan in the South.

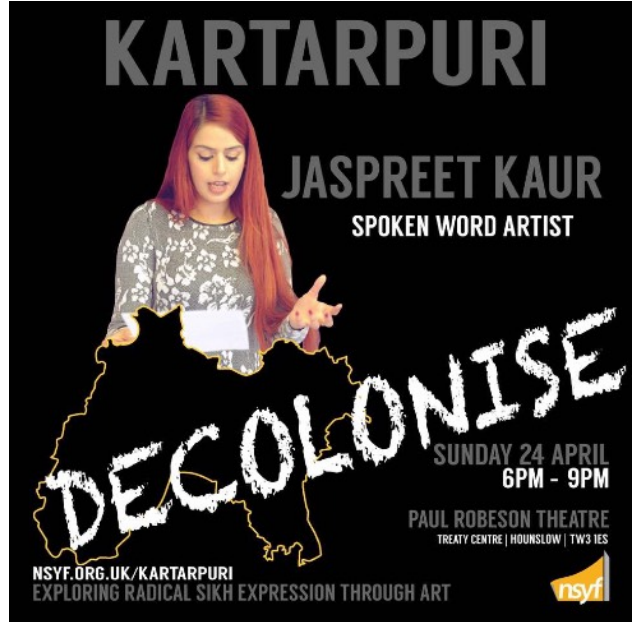


The state's vicious military operations violently eliminated Sikh political activists, guerrillas, and their families from political discourse with impunity in the early 1990s and continues to enforce its erasure with the omnipresence of state violence. It is crucial that the recent wave of repression in the past year is understood in this context of a political conflict between two political entities rather than misrepresented as a problem of terrorism and extremism, or conversely as individual human rights issues that can be resolved through the Indian judicial system.

Sikhs, as a sovereign people, continue to resist and build institutions of sovereign self-governance and will continue to do so in multiple arenas outside the terms and conditions that the state tries to impose. As long as the Indian state continues to repress the right to self-determination and restricts the political space necessary to advocate for Khalistan, the Sikh panth will resolutely continue its movement towards sovereignty by any means necessary.
